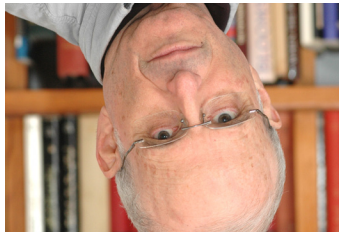

Shiv Visvanathan is an Indian public intellectual and social scientist best known for his contributions to the field of Science and Technology Studies, and for the concept of cognitive justice. He is Professor and Vice Dean of Jindal Global Law School at O.P.J.S. Global University in Sonapat.



Jane Mansbridge is the Adams Professor of Political Leadership and Democratic Values at the Harvard Kennedy School. She is the author of *Beyond Adversary Democracy*, and the award-winning *Why We Lost the ERA*. She was President of the American Political Science Association in 2012-2013.
